About AHEC Scholars:

AHEC Scholars is an inter-professional opportunity open to students in at least a 2-year health education program. It will be an opportunity to learn, work and connect with healthcare professional students in a wide variety of disciplines – from medical students, to nursing, to pharmacy, to physician assistants, naturopathic doctors, and more. This is a nationwide certificate program that will be recognized by potential employers. The program will include opportunities to connect with healthcare providers and stakeholders in your community. The two-year program is two-part: (1) didactics via a course each year and (2) 40 hours per year of community/experiential/clinical training.
