

Whatcom Community College (WCC)

FHS Running Start Course Equivalencies

Fall 2015 and Beyond

All classes must be 100 level or higher to be eligible for credit through the Running Start Program. Any class numbered below 100 must be paid for by the student and will not earn high school credit without written prior approval from the counselor.

Credit Equivalency Each 100 and above class taken at Whatcom Community College (WCC) will be transcribed at FHS based on the following equivalency chart.

<u>WCC</u>	<u>FHS</u>	<u>WCC</u>	<u>FHS</u>
1.0 credits =	.20 credits	4.0 credits =	.80 credits
2.0 credits =	.40 credits	5.0 credits =	1.0 credits
3.0 credits =	.60 credits	6.0 credits =	1.2 credits

Any course below 100 level that is 3 or 5 WCC credits will count as .5 FHS credit. No credit will be given for any course below 100 level that is less than 3 WCC credits.
