Running Start pays for classes that are 100 level or higher.  
 Running Start does **not** pay for remedial classes (99 level or lower).

**Credit Equivalency**

Each 100 and above class taken at Whatcom Community College (WCC) will be transcribed at FHS based on the following equivalency chart. Any remedial courses at WCC will receive .5 FHS credit. Remedial courses that are 1 or 2 WCC credits will not receive any FHS credit.
